**Are you college graduate looking for an opportunity to build an organization's capacity and make a real difference?** The Greenville County Behavioral Health (GCBH) VISTA Program is designed to increase access to behavioral health services for low-income residents of the Upstate region of South Carolina. As a GCBH VISTA, you will devote a year of full-time service at one of five community non-profit organizations and focus on expanding services related to mental health or opioid abuse disorder. VISTAs earn a bi-weekly living stipend and are eligible for an educational award. GCBH VISTAs also receive a housing stipend and access to a recreational facility.
